The Georgetown Project is partnering with local businesses to offer GISD high school students the opportunity to participate in the Summer Youth Employment Program. SYEP is a paid summer internship that offers valuable work experiences in entry-level employment positions.

To qualify, applicant must be:

- Currently enrolled in a Georgetown High School during 2017-2018 School Year
- Must be at least 16 years old
- No previous employment experience
- Willing to work up to 20 hours per week
- Willing to work up to 8 weeks
- Available June and July
- Able to obtain transportation to and from work site
- Have parent signature on Application

SYEP not only connects students with employment, but also provides guidance through the entire employment process. Students will learn how to obtain and keep a job, conduct themselves in a professional manner, value time commitments on the job and constructively use work site evaluation feedback to develop their work place skills. SYEP may be the first opportunity the students have had to learn these skills that are crucial to future employment success.

SYEP Process:

- Complete application (Due by April 15th)
- Attend Job Readiness Training (June 4th)
- Interview with local business partner (June 5th)
- Arrange internship schedule (June 5th)
- Report for internship (June 6th)
- Work Site Supervisor will complete evaluations twice during internship
- Every other week Student and TGP staff will discuss internship
- Pre/Post Essays and develop resume with TGP staff and/or Work Site Supervisor
- Attend SYEP Completion Celebration (August 7th)
