

Classes start the week of September 11 and end the week of December 11.

ESL LEVEL I - SESSION ONE

In Person: Wednesdays, 6:00-7:30pm

This introductory course emphasizes the basics of conversation, reading, writing, and vocabulary development. Childcare is provided for children aged 4+.

ESL LEVEL I - SESSION TWO

In Person: Tuesdays, 10:30-11:30am

This introductory course emphasizes the basics of conversation, reading, writing, and vocabulary development.

ESL LEVEL II

On Zoom: Tuesdays, 6:00-7:00pm

Students learn to understand, pronounce, read, and write common vocabulary in simple sentences reflecting real-life situations.

ESL LEVEL III

In Person: Thursdays, 10:30-11:30am

Prepares ESL students to communicate in jobs, life-skills, or social situations. Students read short texts using simple context clues and decoding skills and write short paragraphs edited for basic grammar and spelling.

SPANISH LEVEL I

On Zoom: Wednesdays, 6:00-7:00pm

Develop a basic understanding of Spanish, focusing on the Spanish alphabet, numbers, dates, times, days, and months.

SPANISH LEVEL II

On Zoom: Thursdays, 7:00-8:00pm

Geared toward the fundamentals of Spanish: basic writing, listening, and vocabulary building.

SPANISH LEVEL III

On Zoom: Thursdays, 6:00-7:00pm

Continuation of Spanish II designed to increase your conversational skills in the Spanish Language—writing, listening and reading comprehension, vocabulary building, grammar, and culture.

SPANISH LEVEL IV

On Zoom: Wednesdays, 7:00-8:00pm

Conversational course for intermediate to advanced students. The class is conducted mainly in Spanish. This course emphasizes enhancing students' listening comprehension and reading, writing, and speaking skills.

CITIZENSHIP PREPARATION

In Person: Tuesdays, 6:30-8:00pm

Focuses on the information and language skills needed to pass the U.S. Citizenship test and interview.
