WHAT IS OUR SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM?

The Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) is an eight-week paid summer internship that offers valuable work experiences in entry-level employment positions.

For over a decade, The Georgetown Project has collaborated with local businesses and nonprofits to provide high school students in Georgetown with job readiness training and a safe, supportive employment experience as they enter the workforce.

WHO ARE OUR FUNDERS?

TO QUALIFY, APPLICANT MUST BE:

- ★ CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN A HIGH SCHOOL OF GEORGETOWN DURING THE CURRENT YEAR
- ★ MUST BE 16 YEARS OLD BY JUNE 1ST
- ★ WILLING TO WORK UP TO 20 HOURS PER WK
- ★ WILLING TO WORK UP TO 8 WEEKS
- ★ AVAILABLE JUNE AND JULY
- ★ ABLE TO OBTAIN TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE WORK SITE
- ★ HAVE PARENT/GUARDIAN SIGNATURE ON APPLICATION
