- Degree in Early Childhood, Child Development, or a related field, and at least 3 years of experience in an early childhood setting preferred.
- Bilingual (English & Spanish) required.
- Strong passion for the development and education of children. Must understand the importance of early environments that protect, nurture, and enrich the healthy development of infants, toddlers, and preschool children.
- Creative ideas for engaging children and families.
- Ability to comfortably manage groups of children in a positive, developmentally appropriate manner.
- Ability to relate to and communicate with parents and caregivers from diverse backgrounds in a caring, non-judgmental manner.
